Towards a full dismissal of charges in the bee case

On June 15, 2008 the Saint-Gaudens Public Prosecutor filed his final conclusions calling for a full dismissal of BASF Agro, Bayer and their respective directors in the high profile criminal case concerning excess mortality among the bee population wrongly attributable to a seed coating product called Régent TS.
